



When it was first built, the Alexandra Terrace marked the beginning of the first building boom and its earliest occupants were members of Calgary's middle and upper-middle class. Past owners include Dr. James D Lafferty, a medical pioneer in Canada who helped found the Alberta Medical Association and the College of Physicians and Surgeons, and Eric Harvie, a prominent Calgary businessman and philanthropist who founded the Glenbow Museum. Subsequent owners include members of the Singer and Belzberg families who were prominent in Calgary's society and Jewish communities.

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
